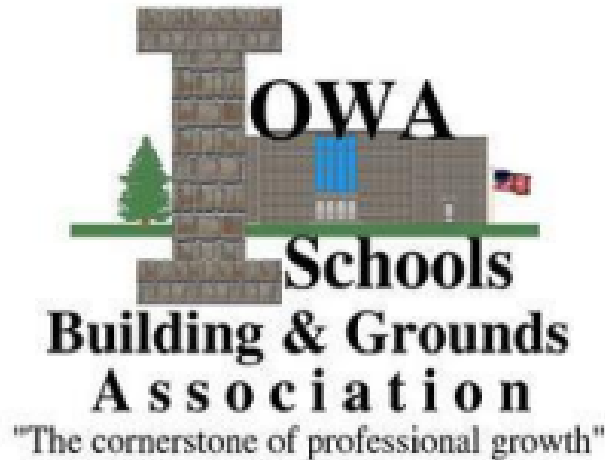

The Clean Energy Districts of Iowa (CEDI) is a nonprofit organization that provides support and technical assistance to its member Energy Districts in counties across Iowa. Through a federal Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG), CEDI's current grant program supports **analysis, strategy and design of energy efficiency, renewable energy systems**, and overall energy use and greenhouse gas reduction projects.

Attendees will have the opportunity to schedule a one-on-one meeting to review their personal IPERS benefits and retirement strategy.

He will also address moisture intrusion, common condensation issues, air leak solutions, and the effects of time and weather on building components. How to handle roof leak response with or without warranties in force. Shive-Hattery offers district wide maintenance programs that address leaks and condition assessments annually to compile 5-year plans for roof maintenance and master planning efforts. We will also discuss Roofing Construction Standards and how to get stakeholder buy-in for future budget planning. Please bring questions related to master planning, envelope problems, or envelope product components, and we will leave time for a group discussion Q&A.
